 Chat GPT Hacks and Al Image Generation
- 45 attended
- Content was delivered by:
 - Ricky Williams (Space Program/YSN Board)
 - Joshua Webb (Kinnovis)
- Ricky talked members through how to get the most out of ChatGPT with a live demonstration and provided various 'hacks' to improve the responses it delivers.
- Joshua followed Ricky, and went into more depth on the capabilities of using the ChatGPT to increase revenue.
